Ground Transportation to/from airport:

SuperShuttle Service — This convenient, exclusive and express shuttle service to and from Reagan National Airport departs every twenty minutes from Gaylord National’s front door to Reagan National Airport, and every twenty minutes from the Reagan National Airport baggage claim. Shuttles run daily: 6:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., with the following prices: \$18.00/one way (per person); \$ 32 roundtrip; and \$78.00/exclusive van service, booked in advance.

On-site transportation options:

- National Harbor Transportation — Luxury sedan services with professional and courteous chauffeurs and shuttles to and from all airports serving Washington, DC. Reservations can be made electronically at www.execucar.com or by calling 1-800-660-8000.
- On-Board Tours — Discover the rich culture and history of Washington, DC with convenient shuttle access right from Gaylord National’s front door. Shuttles run to the old Post office (1100 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW) and Union Station (H Street and 2nd Street, NE) seven days a week: 8:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., departing from the main entrance on the hour, every hour. Pricing is as follows: \$13.00/one way; \$20.00/person, roundtrip; and \$49.50/three day pass.
- Metro bus shuttle services will be available to/from the Gaylord National Resort & Convention Center and the Branch Avenue Metro Station (Green Line). This shuttle service will be available seven days a week from the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. in twenty (20) minute intervals. The pick-up/drop-off location is in front of the Gaylord entrance at the intersection of Waterfront Street and St. George Street in National Harbor.
